2) Per the OEM Contact List filed with the 573 Defect Report, the total US population was 5,920 with 1,503 sold to OEMs with Unknown customer addresses. There are **6,076** engines with known US addresses. **Caterpillar has been notified by PACCAR that their intent was to notify NHTSA that the seven engines previously reported for Kenworth were for field test, however were never sold**

- 4) **4,208** engines have been remedied out of **6,076** => **69% complete**
