In accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and the procedure described in 49 CFR 573.6, the sixth and final Quarterly Report is being furnished. **Updated content is shown in bold font.**

- 1) Date owner notification began:
 - a) First Mailing complete September 10, 2010
 - b) Second Mailing complete December 3, 2010
 - c) Third Mailing complete March 4, 2011
- 2) Per the OEM Contact List filed with the 573 Defect Report, the total US population was 5,920 with 1,503 sold to OEMs with Unknown customer addresses. There are 6,076 engines with known US addresses. Caterpillar has been notified by PACCAR that their intent was to notify NHTSA that the seven engines previously reported for Kenworth were for field test, however were never sold
- 3) A completion summary by OEM is provided on the second page.
- 4) **5,056** engines have been remedied out of 6,076 => **83.2% complete**
