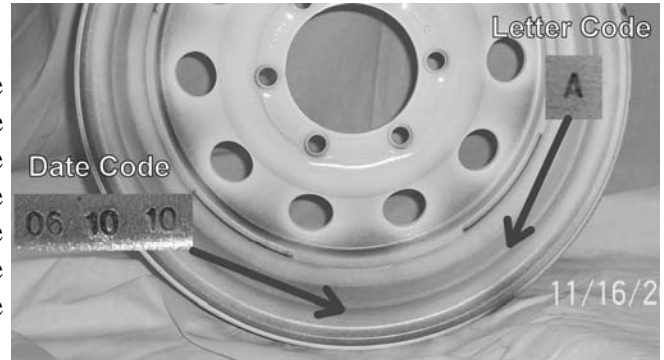
Holiday Rambler: 2011 Mintaro Travel Trailer (30', 31', and 32' floorplans only)

Purpose of Recall

Inspect the rim stamps on the wheels and replace the wheels if they bear specific date and letter codes as explained in the inspection process.

Inspection Process

- Locate the date and letter code on the back side of the wheel in the rim. These codes can be viewed from the front side of the wheel through the wheel slots. The date and letter codes are approximately 6" apart. After the date code is located, the letter code should be visible through the second slot in the clockwise direction. The codes may also be viewed from the back side of the wheel.

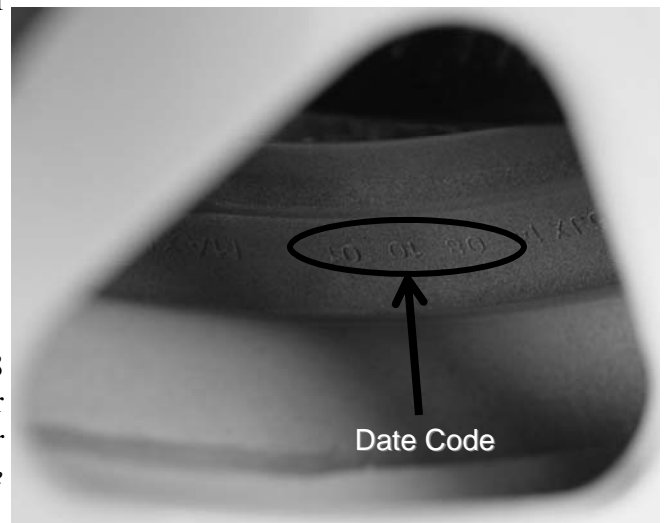
