This amendment to the Vehicle Defect Initial Information Report is submitted to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration by Navistar, Inc on behalf of Monaco RV, a wholly owned affiliate. *(4) PERCENTAGE OF VEHICLES ESTIMATED TO CONTAIN THE DEFECT [Part 573.6 (c)(4)]*

- It is estimated that all (100%) of the vehicles in suspect population could have the defect.

*(5) DESCRIPTION OF DEFECT [Part 573.6 (c)(5)]*

- Under extreme rough road conditions, the suspension equalizer linkages may contact, and possibly damage, brake wiring and/or LP line that are routed above the suspension.
- Damage to brake wiring may result in a loss of braking ability of the trailer which may lead to a crash possibly resulting in property damage, personal injury, or death.
- Damage to LP line may result in a gas leak which may lead to a fire possibly resulting in property damage, personal injury, or death.

*(6) CHRONOLOGY OF PRINCIPAL EVENTS WHICH LED TO DETERMINATION OF A SAFETY DEFECT or TEST RESULTS THAT LED TO DETERMINATION OF NONCOMPLIANCE [Part 573.6 (c)(6)(7)]*

- 11/8/10 – A Monaco RV sales representative reports a brake concern on a demonstration unit.
- 11/8/10 – 12/14/10 - Monaco RV investigates, defines, and contains the issue.
- 1/19/11 – Navistar declares safety recall.

*(7) PROGRAM TO REMEDY DEFECT [Part 573.6 (c)(8)]*

- Brake wiring and LP line will be routed away from suspension components.

*(8) PLAN FOR REIMBURSEMENT [Part 573.6 (c)(8)(i)]*

- Instructions on how to obtain reimbursement for repairs completed prior to recall release will be included in the owner notification letter.

*(9) SCHEDULE FOR RECALL NOTIFICATION [Part 573.6 (c)(8)(ii)]*

- Consumer notifications will be mailed by Monaco RV by February 28, 2011.
