I am responding to the NHTSA acknowledgement letter received on 3/2/11 for the previously sent Safety Recall dated January 25, 2011, ArvinMeritor File: C11AB / NHTSA File: 10E-058, Campaign Number 11V-117.

Information was found by ArvinMeritor which broadens the scope of trailers manufactured by UTILITY. The amendment deals with additional trailers identified in the campaign. The new trailer count increased from 224 trailers to 384.
