Products provided by ArvinMeritor indentified in this notice were specific to a single customer, US Xpress, of which approximately 9,900 units were built by Wabash National in the time frame from April 2005 to July of 2008. Trailer production volume in this same period was approximately 200,000 units. This equates to an estimated percentage of 4.95%
