Pursuant to Part 573 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Volvo Cars of North America, LLC (Volvo) resubmits the following updated information as previously submitted on 05/12/11 concerning safety recall program 11V-286.

573.6 (c) 1: Manufacturers Name

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Country of origin is France for the complete steering gear. The pipe is a tier 2 component and is made by ZF in Germany.

573.6 (c) 2: Identification of Vehicles involved

The vehicles involved in this recall are certain model year 2010 and 2011 XC90 vehicles equipped with V-8 engines. The assembly plants and inclusive dates of manufacture are listed in the chart below; please note that the vehicle chassis numbers and production dates may reflect global production and not only vehicles available for sale in the United States or its territories.

573.6 (c) 3: Total number of Vehicles Potentially Containing the Defect

The total number of vehicles potentially affected within the United States and its Territories is 350.

573.6 (c) 4: Estimated percentage of Vehicles with the Defect

This inspection will be implemented on 100% of the recalled vehicles.

573.6 (c) 5: Description of the Defect

Power steering oil may leak from the oil pipe connection attached to the steering gear valve housing. This may result in slow leakage that can drain the power steering system of fluid, generating noise and gradually decreased power steering assistance.

In a worst case scenario this condition may lead to a sudden and complete loss of power steering assistance. This deviation poses an unreasonable risk to motor vehicle safety.

Root cause: The supplier (ZF) has identified an assembly process issue (including influence of the operator) and a pipe geometry that is out of specification.

Symptom/driver experience: Slow leakage that can drain the power steering system of fluid, generating noise and gradually decreased power steering assistance. In a worst case scenario, this condition may lead to a sudden and complete loss of power steering assistance.

The corrective action is to replace the oil pipes on the power steering rack on all affected vehicles.

573.6 (c) 6: Chronology of Events

02/11/11

First U.S. warranty claim received

02/17/11

Investigation begins based on non-U.S. field reports for non-U.S. specification vehicles.

03/07/11

The issue was presented to the Volvo Critical Concern Group (CCRG). The CCRG group identified and prioritized resources to conduct further testing and analysis to determine the safety relationship.

05/04/11

The root cause and scope were identified.

05/05/11

Safety recall decision by Field Action Board.

Volvo has received 27 U.S. warranty claims and 0 U.S. Technical Reports for this condition. Volvo is not aware of any reports alleging injuries, fatalities, or crashes related to this condition.

573.6 (c) 7: Test Results

Not applicable

573.6 (c) 8: Program for Remedy of Defect

All involved vehicles will be subject to the recall. The target completion date for owner notification letters via first class mail is June 10th. The letter will request that the owner of the vehicle take their vehicle to an authorized Volvo retailer for remedy at no charge. For vehicles remaining in retailer inventory or Volvo inventory, the recall will be performed prior to sale. The corrective action is to replace the internal pipes on the power steering rack on all affected vehicles.

573.6 (c) 10: Copies of Notices, Bulletins, etc.

The complete Recall 242 retailer package was released to Volvo retailers and sent to RMD on 5/17/11. A draft copy of Volvo's Owner Notification letter will be submitted to the agency shortly. Technical information has not been previously released for this condition.

573.6 (c) 11: The Manufacturer's Campaign Number

Volvo has assigned Volvo Recall Campaign Number R242 to this Recall Campaign.
