Pursuant to Part 573 of Title 49 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Volvo Cars of North America, LLC (Volvo) submits the following supplemental information to our May 26, 2011 defect information report for recall 11V-286 (R69217 – R242).

573.6 (c) 6: Chronology of Events – supplemental

- o Supplemental Chronology of events:
 - 0 3/07/11
 - Volvo Critical Concern Review Group prioritized resources for further testing and analysis; the initial contact received by Volvo was from the United Kingdom for a non-US specification vehicle. The scope was initially thought to be on right-hand drive vehicles only.
 - 0 4/20/11
 - Investigation shows left-hand drive vehicles may be affected however a delay due to contract issues with our Tier 2 supplier resulted in a delay understanding which components/vehicles may be affected. Further analysis showed that the leakage of power steering fluid would be at a very slow rate and customers would experience an increasing noise level of the power steering system with gradually decreasing power steering assist.

 - Scope of vehicles showed that US vehicles may experience this condition
- 0 5/5/11
 - Safety recall decision
