**Re: Skyline Recreational Vehicle Brake Recall**

Dear Sir or Madam:

Skyline Corporation, on behalf of its subsidiary manufacturing facilities, has determined that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety may exist in certain recreational vehicles as described below.

Pursuant to 49 CFR Part 573.5(c), Skyline hereby submits the following information:

1. Name of Manufacturer:

Skyline Homes, Inc. is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Skyline Corporation. Skyline Corporation's mailing address is PO Box 743 Elkhart, IN 46515.

2. Vehicles Involved:

The vehicles covered by this recall are model years 2011 and 2012 Nomad, Aljo, Layton, Weekender, Bobcat, Joey and Koala Recreational Vehicle Travel Trailers and Fifth-wheel Trailers. The vehicles were manufactured in Hemet, California between October 1, 2010 and April 30, 2011.

Affected Skyline recreational vehicles are equipped with Lippert Axles as identified by the following serial number ranges:

3. Number of Vehicles:

The total number of vehicles covered by this recall is 544.

4. Approximate Percentage of Vehicles Estimated to Actually Contain the Defect:

Skyline Corporation has identified all 544 potentially affected vehicles. We believe that no others contain the contaminated brakes.

5. Description of Defect:

Brake systems on certain Skyline Recreational Vehicles are potentially contaminated. Due to excessive grease braking effectiveness may be diminished.

6. Chronological Summary of Events Leading to this Determination:

Skyline learned of this defect through internal testing and notification from dealers. Skyline is not aware of any injuries or other incidents as a result of this condition.

7. Program for Remediating the Defect:

Skyline Corporation will send a recall notice to all owners or dealers with instructions for on-site supplier inspection.

8. Recall Notice:
