The following information is an amendment to the information in GM's 573 letter dated November 17, 2011, as it relates to a determination by General Motors of a noncompliance involving certain 2012 model year Chevrolet Colorado and GMC Canyon vehicles.

GM is amending sections 573.6(c)(8) and 573.6(c)(2),(3),(4) of the letter to include 373 vehicles to the vehicle population, provide current build dates and the owner letter mail date.

573.6(c)(8): GM anticipates mailing owner letters to these additional customers on December 28, 2011.

Pursuant to 577.11(e), GM does not plan to provide notice about reimbursement to owners because all involved vehicles are covered under the new vehicle warranty.
