573.6 (c) (3) Number of Vehicles Potentially Containing the Defect 317 yehicles are affected by this defect in the United States.

Percentage of Vehicles Actually Containing the Defect

100% of affected vehicles contain the defect.

573.6 (c) (5) Description of Defect

Due to a production problem in the stitching process of the Sideguard[®] head curtain airbag cushion on one production day, the seam of the airbag may not be stitched properly. Because of this, the head curtain airbag may not deploy in a crash, increasing the risk of injury to vehicle occupants.

VWGoA is not aware on any case with an injury or death caused by this issue.

573.6 (c) (6) Basis for Determination

- End of May 2011: The supplier for the Sideguard® head curtain airbag conducted a COP test (confirmatory of production test) and found that the airbag did not deploy as intended.
- From June to November 2011: The supplier sampled other Sideguard® head curtain airbags produced around the same production date of the "failed" airbag. Visual inspections showed improperly stitched seams in some of these airbags. In additional tests performed with these airbags, all deployed as designed and no other airbag test failed. Detailed research of production continued, and the supplier discovered an irregularity in the airbag stitching process that occurred during one production day.
- November 28, 2011: The matter was presented to the product safety committee at Audi AG for assessment, and at that time the decision was made to conduct a safety recall.

573.6 (c) (7) Noncompliance Test Result

573.6 (c) (8) Proposed Remedial Program

When sufficient quantities of replacement Sideguard® head curtain airbags become available, VWGoA plans to notify all owners of affected vehicles and will instruct them to arrange for an appointment with an authorized dealer. Dealers will replace the left and/or right Sideguard® head curtain airbag at no charge to customers.
