Keystone RV Company has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model 2011 Keystone Raptor 365LEV Fifth Wheels. As a result, Keystone RV is conducting a safety recall.

***Reason for  
this recall***

It has been determined that on some vehicles the fresh water fill/draw line may be connected to the black water tank. The fresh water plumbing will become contaminated leading to an increased risk of personal injury if the plumbing is incorrect, the black water tank contains waste and the water pump is turned on. This service advisory will explain how to correct the plumbing.

The vehicles included in the recall are:

**2011 Raptor Model 365LEV Fifth Wheels in the Serial Number Range BR800855 – BR801143**

Our records indicate unit(s) sold or in your present lot inventory fall within this range, which will require immediate preventative action. **Important:** If some of the units are still in your inventory, Federal Law requires you to complete the recall service on those units before retail delivery. The unit VIN(s) our records indicate are presently in your inventory or have been sold are as follows:

Claims for the units which have been serviced must be submitted. Claims submitted will be used by Keystone to record recall service completions and provide dealer payments.
