Subject: Safety Recall, RVXX1103, Gunite Automatic Slack Adjuster

Safety Recall Summary:

On certain Volvo model vehicles some slack adjusters may have a flow notch in the handle, which under normal braking load may result in a broken housing. If this occurs, the brake at that wheel end may become inoperative potentially increasing the vehicle's stopping distance, which may possibly result in a vehicle crash.

Gunite part numbers are included with the VIN list on the TDP.

The number of vehicles affected is approximately 3,332 (2,765 US, 452 Canada and 115 Export).

Dealer's Responsibility:

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act requires dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Release Schedule:

- Repair Instructions are posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal.
- Vehicle list is tentatively scheduled to be posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal August 11, 2011.
- Owner Notices are scheduled to be mailed on or before August 12, 2011.
