Problem Description On some 2011-2012 Jetta sedan (6 th Generation) vehicles with port-installed Volkswagen accessory stainless steel exhaust tips (part number 1K0 071 910 U), the exhaust tips can extend beyond the original length of the factory-installed exhaust pipes. Due to the extra length added by the accessory exhaust tips, there is an increased risk of being burned. Corrective Action	Parts Information and Allocation No parts are being replaced. If a steel exhaust tip is present, it is removed. Volkswagen will issue dealers a credit for the cost of these exhaust tips, and will rebill the dealer for each affected vehicle minus the cost of this accessory. Additionally, in the next few days dealers will automatically receive a replacement Monroney label for each affected vehicle.


