According to our records, in July 2011, Frontline Communications (Frontline) issued a safety recall for certain Electronic News Gathering (ENG) vehicles for damage to the rear hydraulic brake line.

In our acknowledgement letter of August 8, 2011, Frontline was instructed under the requirements of 49 CFR Part 573.7, "Quarterly Reports," to file six consecutive quarterly status reports to this office. To date, we have not received any of these reports. The first report was due on or before October 30, 2011. You were issued a notice on December 19, 2011, concerning the overdue report. A copy of the notice is enclosed.


Frontline's second report was due on or before January 30, 2011, and the third report was due by April 30, 2012. The company's failure to provide the required information is a violation of Federal law.

You must provide all three reports immediately. The most expedient way to do so is via email to RMD.ODI@dot.gov. Otherwise, we recommend express delivery.
