SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

January 20, 2011

Dear Valued Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Coachmen has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in vehicles/trailers/etc. equipped with certain convection microwave ovens installed in Model years 2010 and 2011 Brookstone Fifth Wheels.

What Vehicles are Being Recalled?

This recall affects model years 2010 and 2011 , Brookstone units that were equipped with Dometic Convection Microwave Oven Model # DOTRV17BC

Our records indicate that you are the owner of one of the affected vehicles as follows:

What is the Problem?

Coachmen Fifth Wheel Division has determined that the convection microwave oven may not have been installed according to the manufacturers installation instructions. The appliance was designed for three types of venting. One of the three types was room venting, which we chose for our production method. By choosing this method, according to the appliance manufacturers installation instructions, we were to rotate the blower unit 180 degrees to direct the exhaust out the front of the convection oven, prior to installing the appliance in the RV.

However unlikely, by not complying with the manufactures installation instructions may present a fire risk.

What Should You Do?

Please contact your dealer or authorized service center to get the appliance serviced as soon as possible. However unlikely, Failure to do so could risk the possibility of a fire resulting in injury or death. If you need assistance locating an authorized service center, please contact Coachmen Fifth Wheel Division at 574 825 8360

What We Will Do?

Coachmen Fifth Wheel Division , is conducting a safety recall campaign to address this issue. An authorized service center will inspect the suspect convection microwave oven. If the defect is present, the blower tube will be rotated to comply with the manufacturers instructions. This work will be performed free of charge.

Pursuant to Federal law, any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten (10) days.
