IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

Dear Civic Hybrid Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

What is the reason for this notice?

Honda has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in certain 2006 and 2007 model year Civic Hybrid vehicles. There is a potential for the voltage converter that relays power from the Integrated Motor Assist (IMA) system to the vehicle's electrical components to fail, which will cause the headlights to turn off, the engine to stall, and prevent the vehicle from being restarted, thereby increasing the risk of a crash.

What should you do?

Call any authorized Honda dealer and make an appointment to have your vehicle repaired. The dealer will replace the voltage converter. This work will be done free of charge. Please plan to leave your vehicle for half a day to allow the dealer flexibility in scheduling.

Who to contact if you experience problems?

Federal law requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within 10 days.
