SAFETY RECALL NOTICE

Dear Sir:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Summit Trailer Sales, Inc. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in the axles supplied with your Summit Trailers. *This risk includes the potential for a crash if the defect is not corrected as a part of this recall.*

! I M P O R T A N T !

- Your Summit Trailer is being recalled
- You should inspect & repair per attached ArvinMeritor document # TP-0860

Why is a recall being conducted?

ArvinMeritor has received field reports of low torque on the spindle nut on ArvinMeritor TL Series installed in van trailers where the stake washer for the nut is staked in a single location as opposed to multiple locations. Low and or no torque on the nut can result in excessive end-play in the wheel-end system and could progress to a wheel separation which could result in a crash.

What are we doing about the problem?

Per the recommendations of ArvinMeritor the owners of the trailers originally equipped with ArvinMeritor TL axles to be contacted immediately and have asked the owners to inspect the wheel ends per Technical Bulletins TP-8060. This bulletin will update the staking to three position and increase the nut torque from -550 lb/ft to 850 lb/ft. Affected trailers are to be inspected as soon as possible by an authorized repair facility. This program will be managed by ArvinMeritor, and will be at no expense to vehicle owners.

What should you do?
