Dear Wabash National Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

ArvinMeritor has notified us that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain TL axles supplied to Wabash National which were installed in Dry Van Trailers built between April 2004 and July 2008. ArvinMeritor has received field reports of low torque on the spindle nut on ArvinMeritor TL Series installed in van trailers where the stake washer for the nut is staked in a single location as opposed to multiple locations. Low and or no torque on the nut can result in excessive end-play in the wheel-end system and could progress to a wheel separation which could result in a crash.

We believe that you currently have or have previously owned one of these units. For this reason we ask that you arrange for your dealer to correct your vehicle without delay. The service and required parts will be provided free of charge.

To correct this condition, your dealer will need to reference the information contained herein and contact ArvinMeritor directly to facilitate repairs in accordance with their procedure TP-0860.

The work will take about 1.5 hours to complete. However, additional time may be required depending on the findings on a unit by unit basis. To obtain this free service, contact ArvinMeritor's service department at your earliest convenience at 1-866-668-7221 for inspection and correction. If you no longer own this vehicle, please inform them of this when you call.

Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall. For more information contact ArvinMeritor directly at the number listed above.

We regret any inconvenience that this action may cause you. However, we are concerned about your safety. If your dealer fails or is unable to remedy this defect without charge and within a reasonable time, you may submit a written complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Avenue SE., Washington, DC 20590; or call the toll-free Vehicle Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY: 1-800-424-9153); or go to <http://www.safercar.gov>.
