## **Safety Recall – Controls and Displays-NVS-221SSe**

Dear Vehicle Owner,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of "The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act." E-Ton Power Tech Co., Ltd. Has determined that a defect related to motor vehicle safety exists in the following models. They fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 123 Motorcycle Controls and Displays.

Eton 50cc and 150cc, Beamer I, Beamer II, Beamer III, (Model Years 1999-2010)  
Eton 50cc and 150cc, Matrix (Model Years 2007-2010)

FMVSS 123 requires particular switch locations. The engine on/off switch should be located on the right side handlebar. The high/low beam light switch should be located on the left handlebar. These switch locations are reversed on the models listed above.

Should the rider attempt to shut off the engine using the handlebar switch, the rider would turn on the high beam lights. Should the rider attempt to turn off the high beam lights, the rider would turn off the engine causing the scooter to lose power. **WARNING:** The loss of power could cause a vehicle crash. To reduce the chance that this could occur, the rider should use only the key switch to turn the engine off. The rider should also use the right side switch only to change the headlights from high to low beam.

To correct this condition, your dealer will perform the service bulletin repairs of reversing the functions of the switch locations set forth by E-Ton Power Tech Co, Ltd's technical department. The work will take less than an hour to complete. However, additional time may be required depending on how dealer appointments are scheduled and processed.

There will be no charge for this service. Your vehicle is affected so please contact your local Eton dealer as soon as possible to make an appointment.
