This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Hyundai Translead has decided that a defect that relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain vehicles Hyundai Translead manufactured for Target Corporation. These vehicles were manufactured between October 2010 and March 2011.

Gunite Corporation reports that an unknown percentage of their automatic slack adjusters (ASA) manufactured by them during the period October 15, 2010 through January 31, 2011 potentially have a flow notch (a type of casting defect) in the handle of the slack adjuster. Slack adjusters with this flow notch could under normal braking load result in a broken housing that may cause the brake to be inoperative, thereby increasing stopping distance and possibly result in a vehicle crash. Enclosure (1) contains a list of affected vehicle identification numbers (VINs) subject to the requirements of this campaign.

Gunite has published Service Advisory GUN2.0014, Enclosure (2), detailing lot and mold line codes and guidelines for inspecting the slack adjuster housing. Gunite has stated that they will promptly and without charge to you replace any slack adjusters containing the matching mold line and lot codes identified in Service Advisory GUN2.0014. All slack adjusters replaced under this campaign should be returned to Gunite. Gunite states they will reimburse for any transportation charges incurred in returning the slack adjusters and reasonable expenses incurred in inspecting the slack adjusters in your possession. Target Corporation may submit a complaint to the Administrator, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, 1200 New Jersey Ave., SE., Washington DC 20590; or call the toll-free

Vehicle Safety Hotline at 1-888-327-4236 (TTY: 1-800424-9153); or go to <http://www.safercar.gov> if Target Corporation believes that the manufacturer has failed or is unable to remedy the defect or noncompliance without charge.

The Gunite campaign has been reported to NHTSA and inspection findings and repairs are required to be reported in accordance with 49 CFR Part 573. Hyundai Translead will provide additional information regarding this reporting in future communications.
