Dear Mr. Cranford:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Geomarc, Inc. has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in the 2007 Prevost LeMirage XL2 motorcoach having VIN 2PCY3349271729152 that you purchased on or about September 29, 2009.

! I M P O R T A N T !

- Your Norcold refrigerator is being recalled
- You should contact Andy's RV service, 2466 Deere Road, Decatur, Alabama 35603, 256-355-2090. They have the parts available to remedy the defect. We have attached a notice from Norcold which gives you greater information about the recall upgrade.

Why is a recall being conducted?

Your Norcold refrigerator contains either a sensing algorithm or a thermal switch to interrupt power to the refrigerator when it detects high temperatures that could lead to a fire. The defect being addressed is the response time of the sensing algorithm and the thermal switch. The remedy is to affix a thermocouple, with a faster response time, to your refrigerator.

What are we doing about the problem?

What should you do?

What if you no longer own this motorcoach?

If you have already paid to have your Norcold refrigerator repaired for this condition, you may be eligible for reimbursement of the charges you paid for the repair. To learn more about what you need to do to obtain reimbursement, please call 1-800-543-1219.
