



Safety Recall 11V-236

Dear Valued DRV Owner,

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Highway Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. DRV has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2011 Select, Mobile, and Elite Suite 5th wheel recreational vehicles it manufactured equipped with ITC 2 wire dimmer switches. This decision was based on information received by DRV concerning the malfunction of these switches.

The dimmer circuit board can overheat during use causing the circuit board and dimmer housing to melt and deform. The failure of the dimmer switch will cause the lights to stop dimming and / or working. An overheated switch can also lead to person injury and / or fire.

Upon receipt of this recall notice, you are urged to take your recreational vehicle to the nearest DRV dealer for repair. *There will be no charge to you for the dealer implementation of this service work!* When you visit your dealer, please present this recall notice, which identifies your recreational vehicle as being a potentially affected unit. The dealer will return a copy of this letter and proof that the service work was completed on your unit to DRV for record retention purposes. If you have already had this repair performed prior to receipt of this letter, please contact the DRV service department at 260-562-1075 for instructions on how to receive reimbursement for the cost incurred in obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.

We would like to apologize for any inconvenience this may cause and would like to insure you that this issue should not affect your confidence in your DRV recreational vehicle. However, we are concerned about your safety.
