



## ***Safety Recall Notice***

***Eldorado National – Aerotech, Aerolite, AeroElite, and Transtech***

Dear Customer:

This **Safety Recall Notice** is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the United States National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and The Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act and is important for your safety.

Eldorado National decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain *Aerotech, Aerolite, AeroElite, and Transtech* buses manufactured between January 2006 and March 2011. Other bus models manufactured by Eldorado National, Inc. during this time period are not included in this recall.

Vehicles subject to this recall campaign were manufactured with Carrier GenV EM-1 Evaporator Units. Analysis of the potential safety issue determined that with time, temperature, and/or vibration, the fuse may loosen in the fuse holder resulting in high resistance and arcing. If sufficient arcing occurs, the fuse holder may melt, and may be accompanied by flame, smoke and potential fire propagation within the EM-1 Units.

### **What We Will Do**

Eldorado National in cooperation with Carrier will provide owners of all covered EM-1 Units a rework for the potential defect at no charge for parts or labor.

### **What You Should Do**

You are to contact the nearest Eldorado National dealer or repair facility to schedule an immediate inspection of your bus. You can also contact Carrier directly at 1-800-793-4741 if you have any questions.

### **Notifications**

We have notified the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration of this recall and the procedures involved.
