NONCOMPLIANCE RECALL G-11505

Dear INTERNATIONAL® Customer,

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Navistar has decided that certain DuraStar, PayStar, WorkStar, TranStar, LoneStar, and ProStar model trucks built 11/5/10 thru 3/10/11 with trailer brake connections are not compliant with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 121, Brake Systems.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

The trailer ABS fault indicator lamp in the instrument cluster will not illuminate due to a programming or hardware issue with the brake system electronic control unit. This condition does not comply with Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 121.

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

An inoperable trailer ABS fault indicator may prevent the driver from being aware of a trailer ABS fault condition thereby possibly increasing the risk of a crash potentially resulting in property damage, personal injury, or death.

DEFECT REMEDY

The repair will involve the reprogramming or replacement of the brake system electronic control unit. Dealers have parts and instructions to repair your vehicle. The repair will be performed free of charge and take approximately 60 minutes to complete.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

Navistar's records indicate that you own a vehicle involved in this recall. The vehicle is identified on the enclosed card.

If you own this vehicle, please schedule an appointment with any INTERNATIONAL® dealer to have your vehicle repaired. You can find your nearest dealer by calling 1-800-448-7825 or by using the dealer locator at <http://www.internationaltrucks.com>.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.
