Owner Notification Letter Dear right hand drive Jeep Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

U.S. Drive Right has decided that certain model year 1994-1996 right hand drive Jeep Cherokee vehicles, imported for sale in the United States from January 2007 to April 2011, fail to conform to Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard 108, *Lamps, Reflective Devices and Associated Equipment*.

In order to comply with FMVSS 108 the following modification must be performed on your vehicle: installation of a rear high-mounted stop lamp.

The remedial work necessary to correct the defect will be performed at no expense to the owner in the following manner: You will receive in the mail from US DriveRight within the next 30 days a package containing the appropriate high-mounted stop lamp and installation instructions. Take these items to a qualified mechanic of your choosing for installation. Upon completion of the installation, send a copy of the invoice for the cost of the installation to US DriveRight at the address provided below for full reimbursement.

Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall. For more information contact US Drive Right at 855-421-4071.
