IMPORTANT RECALL NOTICE

June 24, 2011

Dear Volvo Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Volvo Cars of North America, LLC (Volvo) has decided to conduct a voluntary safety recall on certain model year 2012 S60T5 vehicles.

The reason for Recall 245:

Volvo has identified that the male part of the fuel line quick connector end was produced with dimensions out of specification, leading to excessive assembly force on the female connector assembly and the possibility that the locking function may not be engaged.

If a vehicle exhibits this condition, the fuel line quick connector may detach and the engine may stall, increasing the risk of a crash. The driver may also notice a fuel smell and leakage. A fuel leak in the presence of an ignition source could result in a fire.

The corrective action will be to replace the fuel lines.

What you need to do:

Please contact your authorized Volvo retailer for an appointment. This procedure will be completed at no cost and can take up to 3 hours to complete; however, due to service scheduling and parts availability, the time your Volvo retailer requires to service your vehicle may vary.

If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall. Federal law requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days. Lessor means a person or entity that is the owner, as reflected on the vehicle title, of any five or more leased vehicles.
