Subject: Safety Recall 11V-335

Dear Customer:

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Heartland has determined that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain 2011 North Country Travel Trailers. On the vehicles subject to this recall, the power cord is mounted directly above the exhaust outlet of the furnace. Should the cord hang directly in front of the furnace exhaust while it is running could cause the cord to melt, creating the potential for the cord to have an electrical short; this occurrence could have potential for a fire which could result in serious bodily injury and/or property damage.

At your earliest convenience, please contact your local dealer to set up an appointment to have this inspected and corrected immediately, this service will be performed free of charge.

Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.
