

Safety Recall Notice *Infinity*[®]

Dear Customer:

This **Notice** is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the United States National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Reason for This Recall

Dutchmen Manufacturing, Inc. (Dutchmen) has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain *Infinity* brand travel trailers manufactured between February 4, 2011 and June 30, 2011. Other trailer models manufactured by Dutchmen Manufacturing, Inc. during this time period are not included in this recall.

It has been decided the vehicles subject to this recall campaign were manufactured with the 12 Volt main wiring in the front bulkhead compartment incorrectly routed. On the electrical bus bar mounted to the bulkhead in this compartment, only the main power feed from the disconnect switch should be connected to the lower section of the bus bar. On affected units, the power feed line to the solenoid for the hydraulic pump system is also wired to the lower portion of the bus bar. As a result, this circuit is not protected by an auto reset breaker. In the event of a short or ground, this unprotected circuit could result in a fire.

What We Will Do

Dutchmen representatives have been in contact with the staff at your selling dealership regarding this situation. The remedy is to install an additional auto reset breaker to the bus bar and connect the power feed for the hydraulic pump system to this added breaker, which will give it the required over current protection. The service and parts required for this corrective action will be provided at no charge to you.

What You Should Do

At your earliest convenience, please make an appointment to have your RV serviced by your dealership. The labor time to perform this correction is approximately one hour. Please ask your dealer if you wish to know how much additional time will be needed to schedule and process your RV for this repair. Your dealer is best equipped to obtain parts and provide service to ensure your RV is corrected as promptly as possible.
