



Subject: Eclipse Recreational Vehicles Inc. Incorrect Tire Label Campaign 11V-366

Dear Valued Customer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

Eclipse Recreational Vehicles Inc. has decided that certain recreational vehicles fail to conform to the tire label requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 110, "Tire Selection and Rims." This decision was based on information provided to us by our dealer that your unit may be mislabeled with the incorrect tire size that was manufactured between December 20, 2010 through February 11, 2011.

The Problem:

Vehicles were produced with the wrong tire placard label. A misprinted label could lead to improper vehicle loading specifications or tire inflation which could result in a tire failure. Increasing the risk of a crash

If you own one of the above units, it requires immediate service and continuing use could pose a potential safety hazard.

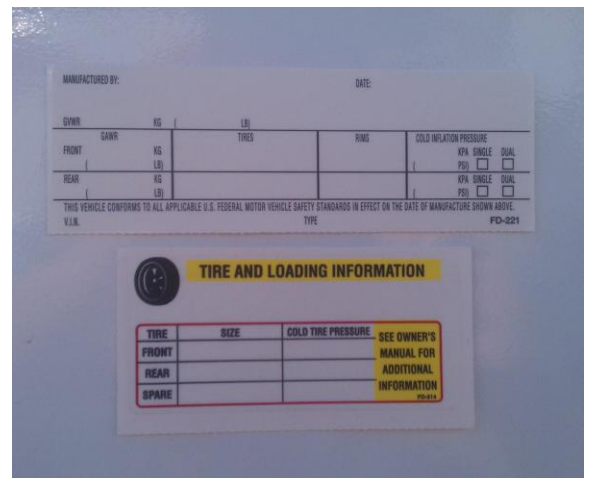
WHAT YOU SHOULD DO

How Do I Know If My Vehicle Is Being Recalled?

- 1) Find your vehicle model and serial numbers; it is located on the left front side of your vehicle, look for the sticker attached to the side wall. See the photo below for the exact location of the sticker.
- 2) Call **1-951-684-6868** to confirm if your vehicle is affected by the recall.

What to Do:

- 1) **Locate the stickers, and replace with the new stickers.**
 - **You can Remove the old Stickers and Install the new Stickers**
 - **You can leave the old Stickers and Install the new Stickers over the old Stickers**



If You No Longer Own This Recreational Vehicle:

If you are no longer the owner of the recreational vehicle, we would greatly appreciate you furnishing us with the name and address of the new owner by calling 1-951-684-6868

You May Receive More Than One Mailing In Regards To The Recall:

Leased Vehicles

The Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act of 1991 (ISTEA) requires that lessors have the responsibility of notifying lessees when a vehicle manufacturer makes a determination of a defect or noncompliance. Therefore, a vehicle manufacturer conducting a safety recall must notify lessors of their obligation to provide a copy of the owner notification letter to each vehicle lessee. The lessor must notify the lessee by first class mail within ten (10) days from receipt of their owner notification letter from the manufacturer; both for initial notification and all subsequent notification. [49 CFR Part 577.5(I)]
