NONCOMPLIANCE RECALL G-11514

AUGUST 2011

Dear IC Bus Customer,

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

IC Bus has decided that certain BE, CE, and FE model school buses built 11/1/06 thru 5/31/11 with rear exit door striping feature code 47NWD may not comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard (FMVSS) 217.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

The suspect buses may have been built without the rear exit door reflective tape required per FMVSS 217 S5.5.3(c).

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

Noncompliance to FMVSS 217 S5.5.3(c) may reduce the conspicuity of the rear exit door for emergency personnel possibly increasing the passenger's risk of personal injury or death during an emergency.

DEFECT REMEDY

The repair will involve the inspection and, if necessary, installation of reflective tape on both sides of the rear exit door. Dealers have parts and instructions to repair your vehicle. The repair will be performed free of charge and take approximately 2 hours ~~minutes~~ to complete.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

IC Bus' records indicate that you own a vehicle involved in this recall. The vehicle is identified on the enclosed card.

If you own this vehicle, please schedule an appointment with any IC Bus dealer to have your vehicle repaired. You can find your nearest dealer by calling 1-800-448-7825 or by using the dealer locator at <http://www.icbus.com>.

If you have already paid for repairs that corrected the defect, you may be eligible for reimbursement of certain repair expenses. Present your original repair paperwork and proof of payment to any IC Bus dealer and your eligibility will be reviewed. You may also submit a claim using the enclosed Request for Reimbursement card.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.

IF YOU NEED ASSISTANCE

If you believe that IC Bus has failed to remedy the noncompliance without charge or within a reasonable time, please follow the procedure described in the Owner Assistance Guide section in your Owner's Manual or call toll free 1-800-448-7825.
