



IMPORTANT SAFETY RECALL

INSTALATION OF REVISED ENGINE MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE AND REPLACEMENT OF ACCESSORY CENTER STAND SPRING (IF FITTED). TIGER 800 AND TIGER 800XC (INCLUDING ABS MODELS) VIN RANGE: 466334 - 514871

Dear

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Triumph has decided that defect which relates motor vehicle safety exists in certain model year 2011-2012 Tiger 800 and Tiger 800XC motorcycles. These models require the installation of revised engine management software to prevent engine stalling on deceleration. Without the revised software, you may experience an unexpected engine stall situation when decelerating which may increase the risk of a crash. Our records show that you are the owner of an affected motorcycle. In addition, should your motorcycle also be fitted with a Triumph center stand kit, we shall replace return, which has been seen to fracture in service. Should the spring fail while riding, the center stand would drop and drag on the road surface, which may also increase the risk of a crash.

VIN:

To correct this condition, your dealer will download a new tune into the motorcycles ECU and if necessary install a new center stand spring. The service and parts will be provided free of charge. This work will take about ½ hour to complete however, additional time may be required depending on how dealer appointments are scheduled and processed. We urge you to contact your local Triumph dealer immediately to arrange an early appointment with the service department.

Federal regulations require that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.

If you had this repair performed before you received this letter, you may be eligible to receive reimbursement for the cost of obtaining a pre-notification remedy of the problem associated with this recall.
