This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Keystone RV Company has decided that certain model 2007 - 2009 Cougar Fifth Wheels Equipped with 235/80R16D Tires fail to conform to the requirements of Part 567, "Certification." As a result, Keystone RV is conducting a safety recall. We apologize for any inconvenience this action may cause you; however your safety and continued satisfaction are of the utmost importance to us.

Reason for this recall

The vehicles subject to this recall campaign were manufactured with the incorrect information on the Federal Identification Tag and Tire and Loading Information Label. The maximum tire pressure was listed at 80 psi instead of 65 psi. Overinflating tires increases risk of tire failure and property damage.

What we will do

We have enclosed the corrected tags to remedy the situation.

What we need you to do

At your earliest convenience, apply the new Federal Identification Tag and the Tire and Loading Label over top of the existing labels. If you require assistance installing the labels, please make an appointment with your dealer and bring the unit to the dealership and they will install the label at no cost to you.
