Dear INTERNATIONAL® Customer,

This notice is being sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Navistar has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain DuraStar model trucks built 2/10/11 thru 2/18/11 with a Meritor MFS08 series non-drive front axle.

REASON FOR THIS RECALL

During the axle assembly process the steering arm attachment bolts may not have been tightened sufficiently.

RISK TO MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY

Insufficient tightening of the steering arm bolts may result in bolt fatigue and fracture and/or arm separation possibly resulting in loss of steering control and increasing the risk of a crash.

DEFECT REMEDY

The repair will involve the inspection, repair (if necessary), and correct tightening of the steering arm attachment bolts. Dealers have parts and instructions to repair your vehicle. The repair will be performed free of charge and take approximately 60 minutes to complete.

ACTIONS YOU SHOULD TAKE

Navistar's records indicate that you own a vehicle involved in this recall. The vehicle is identified on the enclosed card.

If you own this vehicle, please schedule an appointment with any INTERNATIONAL® dealer to have your vehicle repaired. You can find your nearest dealer by calling 1-800-448-7825 or by using the dealer locator at <http://www.internationaltrucks.com>.

If you are the lessor of this vehicle, please forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days to comply with federal regulations.

If you do not own this vehicle, please fill out and return mail the enclosed card so that you will not be contacted again about this recall.
