Problem Description

When installed on certain 2011-2012 Jetta sedan (6th Generation) vehicles, the Volkswagen accessory stainless steel exhaust tips (part number 1K0 071 910 U) can extend beyond the original length of the factory-installed exhaust pipes. Due to the extra length added by the accessory exhaust tips, there is an increased risk of being burned.

Corrective Action

Affected vehicles will be inspected to determine if they have Volkswagen accessory stainless steel exhaust tips. As necessary, replacement stainless steel exhaust tips will be installed.

VIN Ranges & Production Dates

NOTE:

- ElsaWeb is the only valid campaign inquiry/verification source. Check ElsaWeb on the day the campaign work will be performed to verify vehicle eligibility for the repair in order to receive claim payment consideration. Campaign status must show "open".
- If this repair appears to have already been performed on the vehicle but the code still shows open in ElsaWeb, contact Warranty before proceeding further. Another dealer may have recently performed this repair but not yet entered a claim for it in the system.

Dear Volkswagen Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Volkswagen has decided that a defect, which relates to motor vehicle safety, exists in some 2011-2012 model year Volkswagen Jetta sedan (6th Generation) vehicles that could have been equipped with Volkswagen accessory stainless steel exhaust tips. Our records show that you are the owner of a vehicle that could potentially be equipped with these stainless steel accessory exhaust tips.

What Is The Problem?

On some 2011-2012 Jetta sedan (6th Generation) vehicles with Volkswagen accessory stainless steel exhaust tips (part number 1K0 071 910 U), the exhaust tips can extend beyond the original length of the factory-installed exhaust pipes. Due to the extra length added by the accessory exhaust tips, there is an increased risk of being burned.

Precautions You Should Take

Affected vehicles can continue to be driven as usual, however please remain aware that, if your vehicle has the Volkswagen accessory stainless steel exhaust tips affected by this recall, there is an increased risk of being burned by the hot exhaust tips after the vehicle has been driven. Care should be taken to avoid coming into contact with the exhaust tips until they can be removed or replaced under this recall.

What Will Volkswagen Do?

The stainless steel accessory exhaust tips (part number 1K0 071 910 U) affected by this recall were sold and installed on 2011-2012 model year Jetta vehicles after the vehicle's original retail sale. Because of this, Volkswagen is notifying all potentially affected owners and asking them to inspect their vehicle to determine if these accessory stainless steel exhaust tips are installed on their vehicle's exhaust pipes.

- If an affected vehicle has the accessory exhaust tips, dealers will install replacement accessory stainless steel exhaust tips. This work will be performed free of charge.
- Vehicles without accessory stainless steel exhaust tips are not affected by this recall.

What We Would Like You to Do

Please take a moment to inspect the exhaust pipes on your vehicle to determine if accessory exhaust tips are present.





If your vehicle has accessory exhaust tips attached to the exhaust pipes with setscrews (as shown in this picture), please contact your authorized Volkswagen dealer to schedule a recall repair appointment without delay.

This work will only take a few minutes, and will be performed free of charge. Please keep in mind that your dealer may need additional time for the preparation of the repair, as well as to accommodate their daily workshop schedule.





If your vehicle has *only* factory exhaust pipes (as shown in this picture), no recall repair is needed.

Please let us know by signing and returning the enclosed postcard so we can update our records. Once we have received your postcard, you will be removed from any future mailings concerning this recall.

If you are unable to determine if your vehicle has accessory exhaust tips, or if you would prefer not to do the inspection yourself, please contact your authorized Volkswagen dealer to schedule an appointment. The inspection and recall repair (if needed) will be performed free of charge.

Lease Vehicles


Mount two strings weighted on one end centered over each exhaust pipe <as shown>




- Obtain new exhaust tips (5C5 071 911B) and remove screws from tips
- Select correct length screw for the application
- Apply approximately one drop of blue (medium strength) locking compound (shop supply) to each screw, then reinsert into new exhaust tips

Install new exhaust tips onto exhaust pipes so that each tip is ≥ 20mm from the string

- Starting with the rearward most screw <as shown>, tighten each of three screws on both exhaust tips to 2.5Nm using a 3mm hex key, or equivalent
- Remove strings from vehicle bumper
