#### **Revision Summary**

SAGA sheet updated. Criteria statements modified.

#### **Problem Description**

On some 2011-2012 Jetta sedan (6<sup>th</sup> Generation) vehicles with port-installed Volkswagen accessory stainless steel exhaust tips (part number 1K0 071 910 U), the exhaust tips can extend beyond the original length of the factory-installed exhaust pipes. Due to the extra length added by the accessory exhaust tips, there is an increased risk of being burned.

### **Corrective Action**

Depending on the criteria shown in ElsaWeb the repair will be as follows:

- Criteria 01 Remove port-installed exhaust tips from inventory vehicles
- Criteria 02 Replace existing port-installed Volkswagen accessory stainless steel exhaust tips with new tips that are of the correct length.
- Criteria 03 Install new exhaust tips

Dealers should note that Jetta GLI vehicles are <u>NOT INCLUDED IN THIS RECALL.</u>


