Summary:

ENTEGRIS IS RECALLING CERTAIN MODEL YEAR 2011-2012 ANTHEM MOTOR HOMES MANUFACTURED FROM JULY 17, 2010, THROUGH NOVEMBER 30, 2011. THE FRONT TIRES COULD BECOME OVERLOADED DUE TO CARGO DISTRIBUTION WITHIN THE STORAGE AREA.

Consequence:

OVERLOADING OF FRONT TIRES MAY CAUSE TIRE FAILURE, INCREASING THE RISK OF A CRASH.

Remedy:

ENTEGRIS WILL NOTIFY OWNERS, AND DEALERS WILL REPLACE TIRES, AND ON SOME MODELS REPLACE THE WHEELS TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL LOAD CAPACITY, FREE OF CHARGE. THE SAFETY RECALL IS EXPECTED TO BEGIN DURING MARCH 2012. OWNERS MAY CONTACT ENTEGRIS AT 1-800-945-4787.

Please provide the following additional information and be reminded of the following requirements:


As required in Part 573.6, please provide the date of your vehicle weight data and cargo configuration audit.

You are required to submit a draft owner notification letter to this office no less than five days prior to mailing it to the customers. Also, copies of all notices, bulletins, dealer notifications, and other communications that relate to this recall, including a copy of the final owner notification letter and any subsequent owner follow-up notification letter(s), are required to be submitted to this office no later than 5 days after they are originally sent (if they are sent to more than one manufacturer, distributor, dealer, or purchaser/owner).

As stated in Part 573.7, submission of the first of six consecutive quarterly status reports is required within 30 days after the close of the calendar quarter in which the campaign was initiated. Thereafter, quarterly reports will be due on or before 30 days after close of the calendar quarter.
