Dear Ms. Lewis:

Pursuant to Ms. Jennifer Timian's request, the amended 573 notice submitted on January 20, 2012 is being updated and amended. Due to expected part availability, it is Kia's intention to notify all owners in early July 2012 who have not yet had the recall completed to have the driver's air bag clock spring contact assembly replaced regardless of whether the "AIR BAG" warning lamp on the instrument panel in their vehicle is illuminated.

Program to Remedy Defect:

Any owners who did not bring their vehicles in for the recall repair as a result of the "AIR BAG" warning lamp not being ON, will be re-notified by first class mail to bring their vehicle in to have the driver's air bag clock spring contact assembly replaced.

**573.6(C) (8) (ii)**

Estimate Date for Notification of  
Defect to Owners and Dealers

The dealers were notified on February 28, 2012. Owners were notified on March 2<sup>nd</sup>, March 13<sup>th</sup> and April 3<sup>rd</sup>. An additional wave of notifications will be sent on April 12, 2012. Kia also intends to re-notify all owners who have not had the recall repair completed in early July 2012.
