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DEFECT and NONCOMPLIANCE REPORT

On December 20, 2011 Dexter Axle Company decided that a potential defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in motor vehicle equipment supplied to Nu Wa Industries Inc. Dexter Axle Company furnished notification to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration in a Defect and Noncompliance Report dated December 20, 2011. The motor vehicle equipment affected by Dexter's report was electric/hydraulic brake actuator pumps sold for use on various trailers. Some of the potential defective pumps may have been installed as original equipment on Nu Wa Industries Inc. fifth wheel recreational vehicles.

2. Vehicles Involved:

The vehicles covered by this report are recreational vehicles that were equipped with model K71-651-00 (E/H 1600 psi) electric/hydraulic brake actuator with the serial number range of _____ to _____. The vehicles possibly equipped with a potential defective actuator were manufactured from October 10, 2011 to January 30, 2012 by Nu Wa Industries Inc. under the following make, model and model year:

Make - Hitchhiker
Model - Discover America
Model year - 2012

3. Total number of vehicles:

Total number of vehicles equipped with a potential defective actuator is 3.

4. Approximate percentage of vehicles estimated to actually contain the defect:

Based on information received from Dexter Axle Company, no determination can be made.

5. Description of the defect:

Some of these actuator pumps may not have been properly heat treated. This condition can cause premature wear of some critical components in these pumps which can render the unit inoperable.

6. Consequence:

The E/H brake actuator provides braking power to the trailer brakes. Failure of the actuator can result in the loss of braking effort by the trailer, increasing the risk of a crash.

6. Chronological summary of events leading to this determination:

Nu Wa received a call December 21, 2011 from a Dexter Axle Company representative informing of a possible recall for model K71-651-00 E/H 1600 psi) brake actuator. This call was followed by the reception of recall customer letters dated December 20 and December 22, 2011. Nu Wa is not aware of any accidents, injuries or fatalities in its vehicles that appear to be related to this defect. Nevertheless, after reviewing the matter Nu Wa has decided to submit this defect report.

7. Program for remedying the defect:

Nu Wa Industries Inc. will notify customers by mail. Dexter Axle Company will coordinate field replacements for the actuators that are in service.
