Dear Ms. Lewis:

Keystone RV Company ("Keystone") has identified a vehicle non-compliance with 49CFR Part 567 in the recreational vehicles listed below, and is furnishing notification to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration in accordance with 49 CFR Part 573 Defect and Noncompliance Reports.

- A. Recall Population and Vehicle Identification. The recall population includes the following product brands manufactured by Keystone.

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2013 Bullet Premier 31BHPR Travel Trailers Production Date: 4/2/2012 - 7/24/2012	
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The total number of vehicles subject to this recall campaign is:	220
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- B. Description of Defect. The vehicles subject to this recall campaign were manufactured with the incorrect information on the Federal Identification Tag and Tire and Loading Information Label. The corrections to the tag are as follows:

- GVWR 3629 KG (8000 LB) was 3447 KG (7600 LB)
- GAWR 1996 KG (4400LB) was 1588 KG (3500 LB).
- Tire ST225/75R15D was ST205/75R14C
- Rim 15x6 was 14x6
- Tire Inflation Pressure 448 KPA (65 PSI) was 345 KPA (50 PSI)
- Cargo capacity increased by 181 KG (400 LB)

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- The incorrect information on the tags increases risk of incorrect tire inflation and replacement parts leading to an increased potential of tire failure and property damage.
- C. Basis for Determining that a Defect Exists. The defect was discovered during a review of the information listed on the labels. A review of the information stored on file for each vehicle led to the determination of the beginning and ending production range.
 - D. Remedying of Defect. The remedy is to replace the Federal Identification Tag and Tire and Loading Information Label with the correct one supplied by Keystone.
 - E. Owner Notifications. Keystone will notify the owners of the recreational vehicles by letter beginning in August 2012 pending NHTSA approval. A final copy of the owner letter will also be provided to NHTSA.
 - F. Quarterly Reporting Requirements. Keystone will be filing quarterly reports in connection with this recall campaign.
 - G. Campaign Number. Keystone's identification code for this recall is 12-180.
