Dear Associate Administrator,

In the Navistar Campaign 12522 Defect Information Report (Revision 2) submitted on 11/2/2012, it was reported there were 9 DuraStar, 42 ProStar, 876 TranStar and 29 WorkStar units for a total US population of 956 units. On 8/21/2012, one of Navistar's fleet customers (Estes) began validation of a prototype tool required to perform repair. This customer had completed inspection and or repair of 484 suspect TranStar models in their fleet by the time of the release of the campaign on 10/16/2012. These units were inadvertently included with the original 956 units reported in the initial defect report. Therefore, Navistar is amending the total population to 472 units at the time of the campaign release.
