The attached is an update of GM's information submitted on August 15, 2012, December 5, 2012, and June 13, 2013, pursuant to the requirements of 49 CFR 573.6 as it applies to a determination by General Motors to conduct a safety related recall for certain 2006 model year (MY) Chevrolet Trailblazer EXT and GMC Envoy XL, 2006-07 MY Chevrolet Trailblazer; GMC Envoy; Buick Rainer; Isuzu Ascender; and 2005-07 MY SAAB 9-7x vehicles. Specifically, the information submitted pursuant to 49 C.F.R. 573.6(c)(8) and 573.6(c)(10) below supersedes information included in General Motors' letter of March 17, 2014.

<u>573.6(c)(8)</u>: Dealers are to inspect the part number of the door module and, if necessary, install a new door module.

General Motors will provide a mail date for the revised dealer bulletin and owner letters when available.

Pursuant to 577.11(e), General Motors does not plan to provide notice about reimbursement to owners because all involved vehicles are covered under the new vehicle warranty.

<u>573.6(c)(10)</u>: General Motors will provide the dealer bulletin and owner letter under separate cover.
