Dear Maserati Dealer:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act (in the US) and the Motor Vehicle Safety Act (in Canada).

Maserati S.p.A. and MNA has determined that certain Model Year 2008, 2009 and 2010 Granturismo and Granturismo Convertible models, specifically, vehicles indicated in the attached VIN/Assembly/Vehicle Model Code & Production Chart were manufactured with rear tail lamp assemblies (either right or left side) which do not meet functionality and durability specifications. These rear tail lamp assemblies can have a loss of functionality resulting in possible repeated rear tail lamp bulb failure (including the brake lamp bulbs) or an inoperative rear tail lamp assembly which may lead to reduced vehicle visibility and an accident. Please note that the vehicles, high mounted brake lamp assembly is not affected and functions properly.

A total of **1883** vehicles have been sold or leased to customers in the U.S. and Canada. Refer to Recall Bulletin 201201 for the U.S. and Canada VIN and Assembly number list.

The affected vehicles will have the rear tail lamp assemblies checked, and if necessary replaced. All customers will receive notification of the remedy campaign.

The corrective action for the above listed repair will be performed free of charge to the vehicle owner and will require up to approximately 1.20 hours to complete on Granturismo models or 1.40 hours to complete on Granturismo Convertible models. We have accordingly notified to all owners of the affected vehicles, advising the owner of this problem and requests that he or she contact any Authorized Maserati Dealer for the recall action to be performed.

The necessary components will be allocated to you, as needed, from our Parts Department. Upon transmittal of the repair under the normal warranty system, we will of course reimburse you for the parts and the labor necessary to carry out this recall campaign.

Please refer to the attached Recall Bulletin for information and VIN specific details for both US and Canadian models affected by this Recall Campaign.

Obviously, if you have any of the affected vehicles in your stock, you must not sell them until you have performed the necessary repairs on the vehicle. If you have already sold any of the vehicles with the chassis numbers specified (VIN and Assembly numbers) in the enclosed instructions and have not yet sent in the new owner information to MNA, please do so at once so we may notify these owners.
