VEHICLE SAFETY RECALL BULLETIN

Bulletin Date: April 18, 2012

To: All Wildfire Motors Model WF650-C Dealers

Subject: Safety Recall 12V-031 – Nonconforming Motorcycle Brake System

Models: 2009 model year Wildfire WF650-C motorcycles manufactured from April 2008 through January 2009

Wildfire Motors has determined that certain 2009 Wildfire model WF650-C motorcycles manufactured from April 2008 to January 2009 fail to comply with the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 122, "Motorcycle Brake Systems". As built, these motorcycles have a single brake fluid reservoir with a single filler opening, rather than two separate reservoirs with each reservoir filler having its own cover, seal and cover retention device, lack the required reservoir labeling and will not stop the vehicle within the stopping distances prescribed by FMVSS No. 122. A warning lamp indicating brake failure is also absent. Owners should not operate their Wildfire WF650-C until these safety issues are remedied.

Wildfire Motors will, without any charge to the owner, replace the nonconforming brake fluid reservoir with conforming brake reservoirs, add the required reservoir labeling, install a warning lamp indicating brake failure and replace the front and rear brakes as necessary to meet the standard's stopping distances.

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act, as amended, provides that each vehicle which is subject to a recall campaign of this type must be adequately repaired within a reasonable time after the owner has tendered it for repair. Failure to repair within sixty (60) days after tender of a vehicle is prima facie evidence of failure to repair within a reasonable time.

If the condition is not adequately repaired within a reasonable time, the owner may be entitled to an identical or reasonable equivalent vehicle at no charge or to a refund of the purchase price less a reasonable allowance for depreciation.

To avoid having to provide these burdensome solutions, every effort must be made to promptly schedule an appointment with each owner and to repair their vehicle as soon as possible. As you will see in reading the attached copy of the letter that is being sent to owners, the owners are being instructed to contact Wildfire Motors Customer Service if their dealer does not remedy the condition within three (3) days of the mutually agreed upon service date. If the condition is not remedied within a reasonable time, they are instructed on how to contact the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.

Important: Some of the involved vehicles may still be in dealer inventory. Federal law requires you to complete the recall service on these vehicles before retail delivery.

Details of this service are explained in the following sections.

Dealer Notification & Vehicle List:

Involved dealers: Each dealer to whom involved vehicles were invoiced (or the current dealer at the same street address) will receive a list of the involved vehicles by Certified Mail for your information and in the event a dealer wishes to contact its customers in addition to Wildfire Motors.

Important: Wildfire is required by Federal law to notify its dealers by certified mail for all safety recalls. Responsible dealership personnel should be instructed to sign for this certified mail without hesitation as it contains urgent safety recall information.

The Vehicle List is arranged in Vehicle Identification Number sequence. Owners known to Wildfire Motors are also listed. The lists are for dealer reference in arranging for service of involved vehicles.

Completion Reporting and Reimbursement:

Claims for vehicles which have been serviced must be submitted. Claims submitted will be used by Wildfire Motors to record recall service completions and provide dealer payments.

Use the following labor allowance:

Up to \$175.00 per vehicle.

Add the cost of the recall parts package plus applicable dealer allowance to your claim and mail claims to:

Parts Return:

Replaced parts are to be destroyed and properly disposed of.

Vehicle Not Available:

If a vehicle is not available for service for a known reason, let us know by describing the reason on a postcard and mail to the address above.

Following the above procedures will expedite the processing of your claim.
