This notice is sent to you in accordance with National Traffic & Motor Vehicle Safety Act. Gulf Stream Coach, Inc. is issuing a voluntary recall under the provisions of the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

Gulf Stream Coach, Inc. has determined that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety may exist in the following Gulf Stream Coach, Inc. motor homes.

Which models are involved in the Recall?

Certain model year 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2005 motor homes; including brands: Ultra, Conquest, Independence, Endura, Super C, Yellowstone and Cavalier motor homes built with the following floorplans: 6316, 6317, 6330, 8325 and 8328; all of which were manufactured in Gulf Stream's Goshen, Indiana facility during the period of January 5, 2001 to March 14, 2005, both dates inclusive.

What is the Condition?

A condition could exist, which relates to the 110 Volt AC wiring installed in the motor home's cabinet that houses the refrigerator. This wiring may have been installed in a manner that allows contact with the refrigerator tubing, which is heated while the refrigerator is in use. This condition could create points of thermal degradation of the plastic insulation jacket of the 110 volt electrical wiring during vehicle operation, which over time could cause the 110 Volt AC wires to fault, resulting in possible property damage, fire or bodily injury.

PLEASE NOTE: This is not an update or element of any other recall concerning a *Dometic* or *Norcold* refrigerator. **This Gulf Stream recall concerns ONLY a specific segment of electrical wiring, as described above, in certain motor homes.**

How to get the Vehicles Repaired?

STOP USING THE MOTOR HOME IMMEDIATELY. An inspection and possible repair of the 110 volt wiring contained within the cabinetry behind the refrigerator must be completed as soon as possible. This inspection must be completed by an authorized Gulf Stream Dealer or qualified RV service center capable of completing the inspection and repair in accordance with the work instructions. The estimated time for inspection and any repairs by a qualified technician is approximately 2-hours. The costs of the recall inspection and repair will be paid directly to a qualified service center making the inspection and repairs on the affected vehicle.

DEALER CAMPAIGN RESPONSIBILITY

Our records indicate that the vehicle identified above is still in your possession. Federal law requires that this unit be repaired prior to delivery to a retail customer. Therefore this vehicle must be held and repaired per the service procedure of this recall campaign before an owner takes possession.

Repair Procedure

Contact Gulf Stream Coach immediately to obtain a copy of the repair procedure. You can request a copy to be emailed, faxed or sent via regular mail. Failure to follow the approved repair procedure is in violation of this recall.
