Safety Recall Notice

Dear Dealer:

This **Notice** is sent to you in accordance with the requirements of the United States National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

SJC Industries (SJC) has decided that a defect which relates to motor vehicle safety exists in certain *McCoy-Miller and Marque Type I ambulances* manufactured between November 2011 and August 2012. The vehicles subject to this recall campaign were manufactured with the ambulance box mounting bolts not properly secured to the specified torque value. If the bolts are not tightened to the specified torque value, they could become loose and fall off of the vehicle. Under torque bolts and missing bolts can compromise the attachment of the ambulance compartment box to the chassis. If the ambulance compartment came loose, that could result in a loss of vehicle control resulting in an accident. In addition the ambulance compartment could become separated if the vehicle was involved in a crash, putting the occupants at risk for personal injury.

The required action is to inspect the ambulance box mounting bolts and secure to the proper torque value of 52 ft lb. Any missing or damaged bolts need to be replaced.
