Subject: Safety Recall, SC0365, Back Feed through DRL Module

On certain CHU and CXU model vehicles manufactured from October 13, 2006 through December 23, 2009, the low beam headlight operation may be interrupted if a short circuit occurs in the fog light circuit. If the low beam headlights are interrupted, the driver may lose visibility, which may result in a vehicle crash.

There are approximately 5,023 (3,853 USA, 1,168 Canada, and 2 Export) vehicles affected.

Dealer's Responsibility:

The National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act and Canadian Motor Vehicle Safety Act requires dealers to ensure that all new and used vehicles are free of safety defects and comply with all relevant safety standards at the time of delivery to the consumer.

Dealers should make their personnel aware of the safety recall. In the event that a dealer has a vehicle included in the safety recall in their inventory to be sold, the condition must be corrected before releasing it to a customer.

Release Schedule:

- Vehicle list is posted on the Trucks Dealer Portal
- Owner Notices are scheduled to be mailed on or before November 15, 2012
- Repair Instructions are tentatively scheduled for release no later than November 8, 2012
