Dear Mr. Smith and Ms. Kolodziej,

After careful consideration, Snyder Computer Systems, Inc. dba Wildfire Motors (Wildfire") has concluded that it has no alternative other than to file an action for judicial review of the administrative order of November 14, 2012. I attach a courtesy copy of the complaint for judicial review that we are filing today in the United States District Court for the Southern District of Ohio.


According to 5 U.S.C. §705, the agency may, if justice so requires, stay its order pending judicial review. As a courtesy to you and to the court, we are requesting a stay pending review from the agency before asking for it from the court.

Justice requires that the stay be granted, because (1) Wildfire is not in a financial position to comply with the order even if it were lawful and cannot truthfully swear (under penalty of perjury) that it can complete the

repurchase recall as demanded in the Order and (2) contrary to the order, the Wildfire stopping distance tests were documented in the same manner and on the same forms as the Honda-owned TRC testing facility and overwhelmingly demonstrate compliance with the standard.
