Dear Mr. Smith,

I represent Snyder Computer Systems, Inc. d/b/a Wildfire Motors (hereinafter "Wildfire"). The purpose of this letter is to request an additional thirty (30) days to either comply with the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (hereinafter "NHTSA") "Findings, Conclusions and Order on Wildfire's Failure to Reasonably Meet Its Recall Remedy Requirements" dated November 13, 2012 (hereinafter "Order") or seek judicial review of the same.

In the course of reviewing Mr. Snyder's options related to the Order, Mr. Snyder just today, November 21, 2012, received news that his sister had passed away. Mr. Snyder is in his seventies, his parents are deceased, and will be responsible for the handling of his sister's affairs. He will be out-of-town for at least the next seven (7) to ten (10) days. Moreover, Mr. Snyder, as President of Wildfire, is the sole individual with all of the necessary and relevant information to properly comply with the Order and/or file for judicial review of the Order.

In light of Mr. Snyder's unfortunate family circumstances and necessary duties attendant to such circumstances, as well as the Thanksgiving holiday, Mr. Snyder respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days to either comply with the Order or seek judicial review of same.
