SUBJECT: SAFETY RECALL OF ANTILOCK BRAKE SYSTEM INDICATOR LAMPRef: NHTSA #12V-018
TEMSA TS35- S02

Attention Owner:

This notice is sent to you in accordance with the National Traffic and Motor Vehicle Safety Act.

TEMSA GLOBAL (TEMSA) has decided that certain model year 2011-2012 TS35 buses fail to conform to the requirements of Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No.121 "Air Brake Systems". The Anti-Lock Brake System (ABS) malfunction indicator lamp does not illuminate as a check lamp function when the ignition is turned to "ON" or "RUN" position. Please see the enclosed TEMSA Service Bulletin [TS35-S02] for further information and remedy action.

Without the check lamp feature, the driver may not be aware that the indicator lamp is not working properly, and if there were an ABS problem, the driver would not receive a warning. A malfunctioning anti-lock brake system may increase the risk of a crash.

The vehicles that are subject to this notice are the following model year 2011– 2012 TS35 Temsa coaches :

Temsa is conducting a recall to remedy ABS check lamp function. The recall work will be provided at no cost to you.

Temsa records indicate that you are the owner or operator of the following vehicle(s) included in this recall:

Temsa strongly urges you to have the recall work performed on your vehicle(s) as quickly as possible. These repairs will take approximately 20 minutes to complete."

If you have sold or otherwise transferred the vehicle(s) identified above, please contact the Temsa at 1-407-601-7801 with all of the information you have regarding the current owner/operator of the vehicle(s). Federal regulation requires that any vehicle lessor receiving this recall notice must forward a copy of this notice to the lessee within ten days.
